## GOLF CAPTAIN REPORT

From April This year 2013, Eldoret Club has hosted golf tournaments on all weekends, thanks to our ever increasing corporate sponsors.

The average number of participants has been seventy five with the highest so far being 116 during the KCB Golf series held on 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2013.
